# **SUNDAY 25 AUGUST -** Tour Historic **KINGSTON HOUSE,** which was built in 1840, and is one of South

Australia's oldest remaining houses still in use. Kingston House, located at 5 Cameron Avenue, Kingston Park, is the oldest building in the Holdfast Bay Council area. It is situated on a three-acre reserve, commanding a magnificent view of the coast. It was the country home of the Kingston Family – a family who were extremely influential in the founding of the South Australian colony and of the nation. Join us and enjoy a nice afternoon tea as well as the tour. THURSDAY 26 SEPTEMBER - BUS TOUR TO MONARTO ZOO - This promises to be a wonderful full day outing to the Monarto Safari Park. It is the largest safari park outside Africa, spanning more than 1.500 hectacres and home to more than 50 species of exotic and native mammals, birds and reptiles.
